About This Release

We are happy to announce global availability of Dome SWG 2.20. This release provides improvements in and various fixes. This document communicates all the major changes in Dome SWG 2.20.

Compatible Products

Below versions of Dome SWG(Dome Standard) is subject to the new release, and will be updated to 2.20

- Dome Standard 2.19

Improvements

- SSL Bypass option is now supported in PAC Scripts.
- Computer Names now can be used for creating policies similar to Active Directory User/Group/Department information
- A new user type as "Computers" are available under User Management where administrators can add Computernames to be used in policies. This is suitable for companies without Active Directory or different usernames set for computers such as using Dome Secure Web Gateway with local work groups.
- Computer name based reporting is now available under Reports and Overview Features.
- Dome Agent's now can be installed on top of previous versions without having to uninstall existing agent.

Fixes

- "Disable if Gateway Not Reachable" Feature is now removed from Dome Agent.
- Certificate Generation on Dome Agent was causing latency at first installation, 2.20 fixes this issue.
- At Roaming State, some Dome Agent installed machines were unable work with Active Directory, 2.20 fixes this issue.
- Reinstallation of Dome Agent into systems that previously had Dome Agent were causing crashes, 2.20 fixes this issue for good.
- Some PDF files were not opening correctly if behind Dome Proxy, 2.20 fixes this issue.
- File Type Filtering rules for PNG and JPEG were causing intermittent misbehaviour compared to the rules created. This release solves the issue for good.
- On heavy load, misclassification issues were seen for URL Filtering Categories, 2.20 fixes this issue.
